Bayside Beach Opening Day - Saturday, May 16, 2020

- ✓ With the Coronavirus-19 pandemic and Michigan's Stay-at-Home order in effect until April 30, 2020 and this order possibly being extended into May, beach opening will be conducted differently from years past to avoid compromising the health of members and to avoid a \$1,000.00 misdemeanor fine.
- ✓ Included with this newsletter are your 2020 registration form and a flyer regarding the Upper Straits Lake fireworks show scheduled for July 11, 2020.

PLEASE UPDATE YOUR INFO on the registration form, especially your E-MAIL ADDRESS!!

Dues are as follows:

Regular membership dues	\$300.00 (includes 2 keys)
Retiree membership	\$ 50.00 (includes 2 keys)
Mooring dues	\$200.00
Extra keys* (up to 2 extra)	\$ 3.00 per key

NOTE: Each membership is limited to 2 "free" keys (cost included in membership dues) and 2 extra keys for a total of 4 keys. The cost for each extra key is \$3.00. REMEMBER: ONLY 4 KEYS MAXIMUM PER MEMBERSHIP! Keys will be delivered to you by opening day, Saturday, May 16, 2020. (The gate locks will be changed on Saturday, May 16, 2020.)

- ✓ The Bayside Beach Association board is asking you to **return by mail** your completed, updated registration form and your check for payment of dues payable to Bayside Beach Association. These items are **due before or on Saturday, May 9, 2020.**

- ✓ If dues are not paid by June 15, 2020, a late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed.
- ✓ For those who will be paying mooring dues, payment is due before or on May 9, 2020.
- ✓ **Sign-up for work hours will be done differently this year.** Bobbie Sue Young and Dean Hare have generated a Google document that you will be able to access from the Bayside Beach website (www.baysidebeach.com) as well as from a link in an e-mail blast that will be sent to those who have provided e-mail addresses to the association. (Typical opening day work will have to be performed in a different way to allow for social distancing. You will be able to see this in the schedule set-up on the Google document for opening day chores.) Of course, you may sign up for work hours for later in the summer if you prefer not to do opening day chores. - ✓ **Members should sign up for work hours as soon as the Google document is available.** Members will not receive gate keys until they have signed up for work hours, mailed in their updated registration forms, and paid their dues. **Keys will be delivered to you by beach opening, May 16.**
- ✓ ALL NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT (KAYAKS, ROW BOATS, ETC.) MOORED AT/ON THE BEACH MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE MOORING CHAIRPERSON. Members may request registration forms from Jeff Parko by writing to him and forwarding your request to him at 4444 Welland Drive West Bloomfield, MI 48323. Any non-motorized watercraft not registered will be removed from the beach area and be locked up behind the storage garage.

Work Hours (general info and contact info)

Per the Bayside Beach Rules and By-Laws, each membership is responsible for a minimum of six (6) work hours of service to Bayside Beach each year. Failure to comply will result in a financial assessment equal to one year's dues. (If a portion of a membership's work hours is performed, then the financial assessment will be pro-rated.) Fortunately, there are plenty of opportunities for a member to serve his/her work hours. It is the member's responsibility to report his/her work hours to Bayside Beach's work chairperson, Dean Hare. MUSIC on the LAKE: Music on the Lake events have not yet been scheduled due to the stay-at-home order and uncertainty as to when Michigan will be fully up and operational.

Beach Party Rules: Private parties will only be allowed once the stay-at-home order is lifted.

1. If you are hosting a party for 25 or more guests, a party application must be filled out and filed no later than 10 days prior to the party.
2. A limit has been set at 3 parties per day OR 100 total guests per day.
3. You are responsible for your guests' behavior and for ensuring all beach rules are followed.
4. You must limit your space under the pavilion to 2 picnic tables.
5. The gates must always be LOCKED. Restroom doors must stay closed.
6. Due to limited parking, please carpool or shuttle your guests.
7. NO GLASS or PETS are allowed.
8. Only 1 watercraft is allowed per membership (includes guests).
9. You are responsible for cleaning up after your party. This includes the restrooms!
10. Clean-up includes lugging all trash to the dumpster by the storage shed.
11. Members must always be present with their guests.
12. A fully refundable deposit of \$150.00 is required with your party application.
