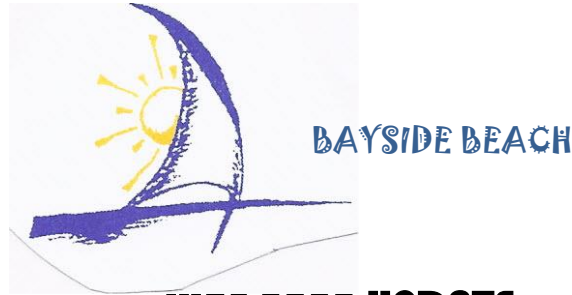

## Bayside Beach Watercraft Registration

Last year, Bayside Beach Association members were asked to register any non-motorized watercraft that was to be left on shore or on the kayak rack. This year the registration process has been modified in 2 ways.

1. Each non-motorized watercraft owner will be issued an official Bayside Beach decal with an assigned number for each member. In case any such watercraft is cast adrift on the lake and ends up moored on some other lakeside property, it will be much easier to identify the owner and return the watercraft to that owner.
2. The Bayside Beach Association Board of Directors has decided to extend this Bayside Beach Association registration to motorized watercraft as well. An official Bayside Beach decal will be issued for each motorized watercraft that a member intends to use on Upper Straits Lake. The first decal is included with dues. Any additional decals will cost \$5.00 each.

A letter will be mailed out in mid-June to those members who have included State of Michigan registration numbers on their 2020 Bayside Beach registration forms (given to Jo Anne Clark along with payment of beach dues in May/June 2020). The letter will provide more details about the registration process, 1 decal (for 1 watercraft to be registered), and a due date for **all** registrations. If a member has more than 1 watercraft that he/she uses at the beach, then (an) additional decal(s) must be procured. Please contact Bobbie Sue Young at 517.304.8505 to arrange for the purchase of (an) additional decal(s).

## Our New Boat Ramp

Our boat ramp is finally completed! The concrete approach was damaged last year, and further expenditure had to be spent to repair it. To protect the investment made in upgrading the boat ramp, it is imperative that boaters use the ramp properly. (Improper usage of the boat ramp may damage the integrity of the ramp or may damage the boats being loaded or unloaded.) **No power loading or power unloading is permitted EVER!** Members who misuse the ramp will be fined the first time and will lose their beach membership upon further infraction.

### Special Consideration

**GOLF CART TRAFFIC:** Please park golf carts in the designated areas by the south and north parking lots. Also, please exercise caution when driving in the beach park. When it is particularly busy, please completely avoid driving on the concrete path or on the sand.

**CONCRETE PATH:** Please do not place picnic tables on the concrete path. Also, please do not park golf carts, etc. on the concrete path.

**NO GLASS ALLOWED AT THE BEACH!**

For everyone's safety, please do not bring/use glass of any kind at the beach.

**Weed Harvesting Info:** This year, the USCLA (Upper Straits Clean Lake Association) has scheduled both chemical and manual weed harvesting. Check the website, [www.upperstraitslake.org](http://www.upperstraitslake.org) for details.
