Bayside Beach Opening Day - SATURDAY, MAY 6, 2023 @ 9AM

Bayside Beach Association's treasurer and membership chairperson will be on hand at the beach from 9AM to NOON to collect dues (per the amount indicated on the enclosed statement/registration form) and to hand out gate keys. PLEASE UPDATE YOUR INFO on the registration form, especially the first and last names of each adult beach member in your home, your phone number(s) and birthdates! Dues are as follows: Regular membership dues \$300.00 (includes 2 keys) Retiree membership dues \$50.00 (includes 2 keys) Mooring dues \$200.00 Extra keys* (up to 2 extra) \$ 3.00 per key
To qualify for retiree membership dues, a member must be retired, must be a member in good standing for at least 5 years or longer, and must have reached the age of 62. If you meet the 3 criteria mentioned, you must fill out an application for a "Change in Membership Status" and submit the application for board approval. (Proof of retirement should be included.) This application will be available at the beach on opening day and as a downloadable PDF on the beach website.
Each membership is limited to 2 "free" keys (cost included in membership dues) and 2 extra keys for a total of 4 keys. The cost for each extra key is \$3.00. REMEMBER: ONLY 4 KEYS MAXIMUM PER MEMBERSHIP!
No cash will be accepted. Please make your check payable to Bayside Beach Association.
If dues are not paid by June 15, 2023, a late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed.
For those who will be paying mooring dues, payment is due before or on May 6, 2023.
There are limited work hour assignments available for opening day chores.
ALL MOORED, MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE MOORING CHAIRPERSON (using a Mooring Worksheet, application found on-line).
NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT (kayaks, paddle boats, etc) MUST BE REGISTERED WITH
THE BEACH ASSOCIATION. Registration forms will be available on opening day. If you use/store more than 1 non-motorized watercraft at the beach, the cost of the first registration decal is included in your dues payment. However, there is a minimal fee of \$5.00 for each additional decal.
IN ORDER TO PROCURE YOUR BEACH KEY(S), MEMBERS MUST FIRST SIGN UP FOR WORK HOURS. Some members have already signed up for their hours (at the January general membership meeting, accessing the Google work hour sign-up sheet on the beach website, or by contacting Dean Hare, our work assessment chairman). <u>REGISTRATION</u> (forms, dues, keys): If you are unable to pick up your keys on opening day, please FIRST be sure you have signed up for your 2023 work hours. WORK HOURS (general info and contact info)

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BEACH PARTY RULES: Private parties are at the host's/guests' risk. If you are hosting a party for 25 or more guests,

a party application must be filled out and filed no later than 10 days prior to the party.

- 1. A limit has been set at 3 parties per day OR 100 total guests per day.
- 2. You are responsible for your guests' behavior and for ensuring all beach rules are followed.
- 3. You must limit your space under the pavilion to 2 picnic tables.
- 4. The gates must be LOCKED at all times. Restroom doors must stay closed.
- 5. Due to limited parking, please car pool or shuttle your guests.
- 6. NO GLASS or PETS are allowed.
- 7. Only 1 watercraft is allowed per membership (includes guests).
- 8. You are responsible for cleaning up after your party. This includes the restrooms!
- 9. Clean-up includes lugging all trash to the dumpster by the storage shed.
- 10. Members must always be present with their guests.
- 11. A fully refundable deposit of \$150.00 is required with your party application.
