## **Bayside Beach Association Board Candidates**

These are the candidates running for board positions. Their bios are in alphabetical order.

**Joe Bohez** – Joe has lived in West Bloomfield for 33 years, 26 of those years as a member of the Bayside Beach Association. He has served as a beach board member for several years, including this past year. Joe regularly contributes to making the beach a pleasurable place to enjoy summer events, especially through his efforts to assist in event set-ups, and food preparation at Music on the Lake (as well as other events). Joe is a friendly representative of the board and is welcoming to all members of the association.

**Mike Burwell** – Mike has been a Bayside Beach Association member since 1988, has served and is serving as our Board Chairman for a total of 29 years, and has used his expertise as an attorney to represent our Association in various legal situations (with West Bloomfield Twp., Twin Beach Golf and Country Club, Oakland County Road Commission). #### NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT
